

# Tathra Town Map

## Walking Tracks

- 1 Mogareeka Cycle/Walkway**  
An easy 45 minute walk, excellent for your daily exercise. The bitumen path is shared with cyclists – stay alert and to the left. There is a well-appointed BBQ area at Lions Park at Mogareeka. Length: 2.5km
- 2 Tathra Headland Walk**  
An accessible walking path around the Tathra Headland connecting to Tathra Wharf, taking in the Memorial Gardens and offering breathtaking views.
- 3 Tathra Forest Wildlife Reserve**  
A medium 90 minute return walk on dirt/bush tracks through rainforest and wetlands. Unique species of animals and birdlife. Car parking available. Length: 3km
- 4 Tathra Coastline Walk**  
Medium/hard 60 minute return walk on dirt/bush tracks with spectacular views. Follows the cliffline and links Tathra Wharf with Kianinny. Length: 2km
- 5 Kangarutha Walking Track**  
A medium/hard walk on a dirt bush track. Follows the coastline to Wallagoot Lake. Take plenty of water. Arrange a car shuffle. 4 hours one way. Length: 9km
- 6 Fords Headland Track**  
A medium walk or bike ride on a fire trail loop around the historic "Fords Farm" area. An easy diversion will take you to the southern end of Moon Bay. 1 hour around the headland or 1 1/2 hours to Moon Bay and return.

### Tathra Rockabilly Retro Week

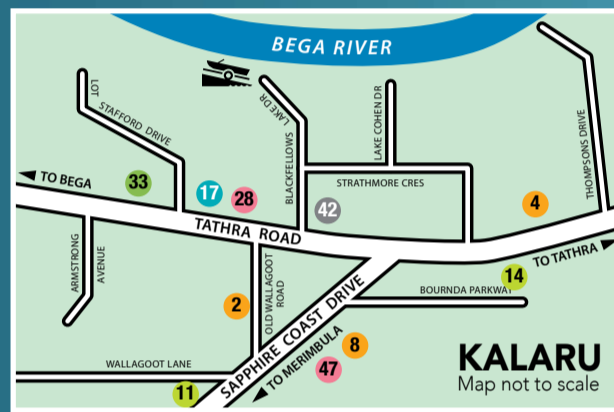

## Tathra Beach

The pristine waters of the Sapphire Coast create an oyster experience that wins hearts and awards and Tathra Oysters are some of the most awarded in the country. While you're in town, visit the "farm gate," have a yarn to the producers and even learn how to shuck an oyster.



## Tathra Oysters

One of the most significant structures on the Sapphire Coast, it's also renowned as one of the best fishing wharves in all of Australia and is classified by the National Trust as the only remaining steamship wharf on the Australian coastline. Don't miss the fascinating museum which offers a glimpse into the history of our region. You can also shop for local wares, enjoy coffee, delicious local produce and THAT view.

## Tathra Wharf

Our national parks are ideal to get back to nature. Milmosa Rocks National Park offers amazing beaches and pure lagoons, and you'll be spoilt for choice with lookouts, rainforest pockets and historic sites to explore. Walk along the cliff tops of Boulda National Park from Kianinny Bay to Boulder Bay then on to Wallagoat Lake on the Kangarutha walking track. Or stop in at Hobart Beach, with its excellent camping facilities and stunning headland.

## Accessible nature

For visitors, a forage for seasonal produce in our markets, local cafes and wholesalers is a must do. Our restaurants and cafes are diverse and there's a venue to suit every palate. Quirky cafes with laid back beachy vibes, magnificent dining rooms overlooking the ocean, cosy dinners in heritage houses, fish and chips right on the beach and much, much more. ## Play in nature

Just west of Tathra you will find yourself in Biamanga National Park, a scenic place to picnic and enjoy the short walk to a lookout with views over Mumbulla Falls. The Aboriginal custodians request that visitors, through respect, do not swim in the Mumbulla Falls area - a site that is sacred to the Yin People.

## Whales in Nature

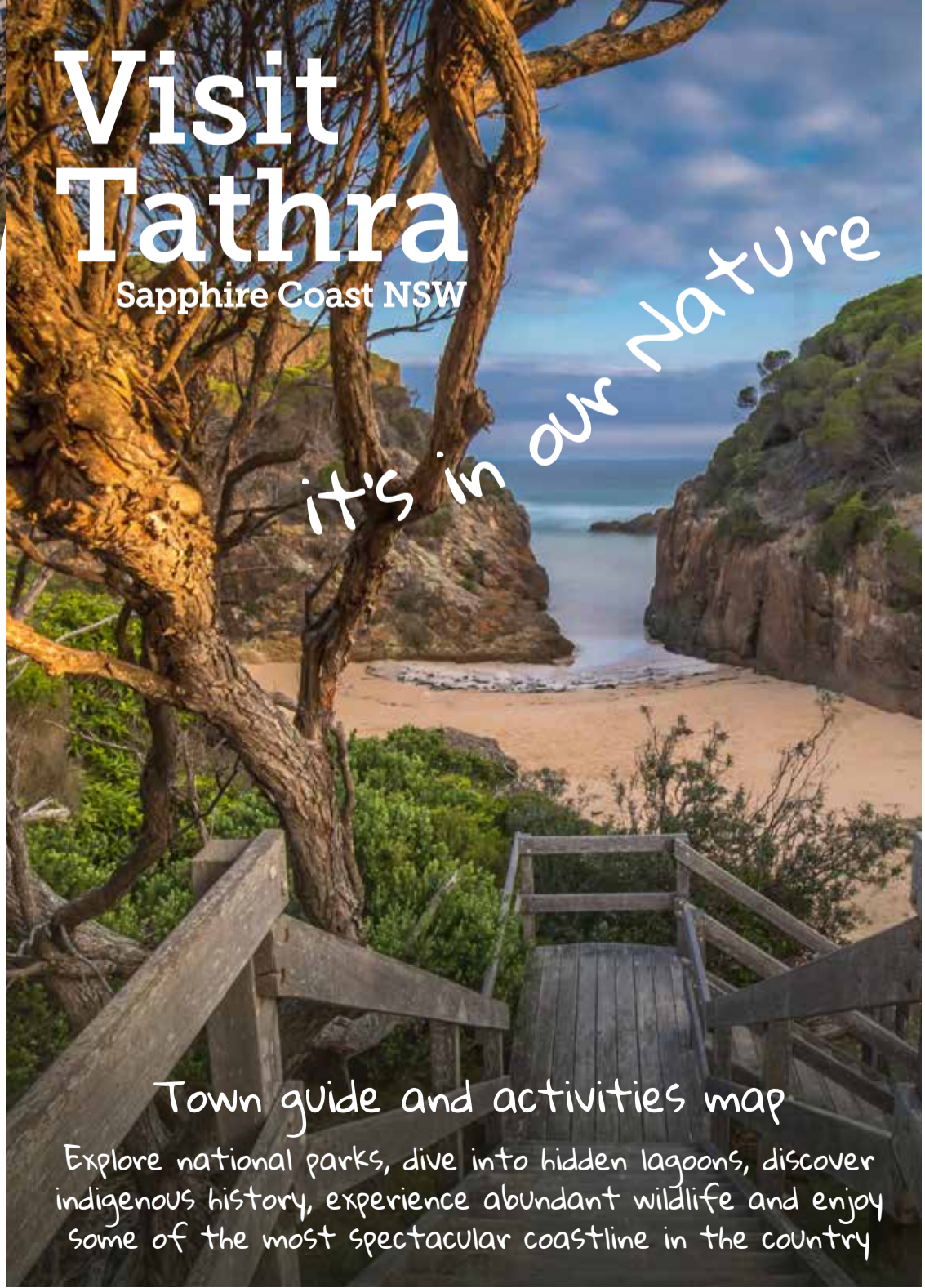
